## Bruno Mars

Peter Gene Hernandez, born on October 8, 1985, known as *Bruno Mars*, is a famous American singer. Born and raised in Hawaii, he showed his gift for music at a young age. After he finished high school, he moved to Los Angeles to keep his musical life going.

Mars came from a musical family. He said, "Growing up in Hawaii made me the man I am. I used to do a lot of shows in Hawaii with my father's band. Everybody in my family sings and plays instruments. I've been surrounded by it." When he was two, his father called him "Bruno" because he looked like a famous wrestler Bruno Sammartino. "A lot of girls say I am out of this world, so I guess I'm from Mars." That's why he uses Bruno Mars as his stage name.

*Just the Way You Are*, one of his most popular songs, was released on July 19, 2010, and has become the top of the *Billboard Hot 100*. Even he was arrested in Las Vegas because of cocaine on September 19, 2010, he still worked hard to get back to his life. In 2011, he was named one of *Time Magazine's 100* most powerful people in the world.

He is only thirty, but he has already experienced the sweetness of success and the difficulties of being arrested. But one should never give up his dream when there is still chance to make changes, just like Bruno Mars.

Neil Armstrong

On August 25, 2012, we lost a great astronaut, Neil Armstrong. He was a famous American astronaut. He was well-known because he was the first person to walk on the moon.

Neil Armstrong was born on August 5, 1930, on a farm in Ohio. His love for flying began very early. When he was eleven, he asked his parents if he could take flying lessons. They said yes only if he would work for it. Then he worked at the airport and other jobs to make money. On his sixteenth birthday, he got his student pilot's license even before his driver's license. After he finished college, Armstrong became a test pilot. He flew all kinds of planes to test them out to see how well they flew.

Armstrong became an astronaut in 1962. His first mission in space was the Gemini 8. After the Gemini mission, he was the leader of the Apollo 11 mission. On July 20, 1969, Armstrong became the first person to walk on the moon. When he stepped on to the moon, he said his famous saying, "That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind." Although he is dead, he will always be remembered as the first man to walk on the moon.
