Iruma, a city in Japan, is using the QR code stickers to track down the old people with dementia. A report said that 12,208 people with dementia were missing in Japan in 2015. Most of them could go home safely in a few days, but 479 were dead when people found them. And 150 people were never found. Iruma used to give the old people with dementia small GPS devices to track down their action. However, those devices didn't work because those people often forgot to take the devices with them when they left the house. As the number of missing people is rising in Japan lately, they began to use the QR code stickers to help the worried people find their loved family.

The 1 cm QR code sticker doesn't track the person's action, but it has a record of his (or her) name, address, and phone number. The old people can paste the QR code stickers on their fingernail or on their key. If they are missing, the police can know their names and phone numbers by scanning the QR code sticker. In this way, the police can call their family and help them go home safely.
